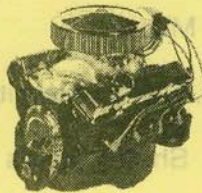

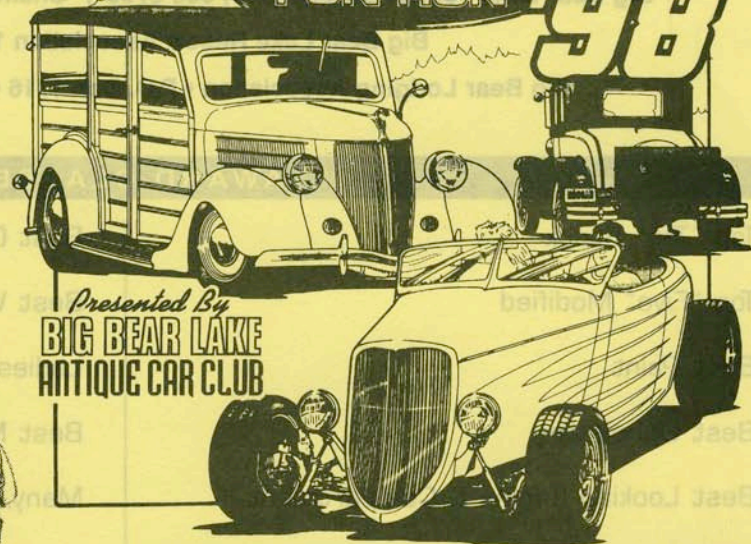

Pine Knot Avenue and Bartlett Road will be closed to through traffic as will Village Drive from Knickerbocker on the east to Bonanza Trail on the west. Street closures will begin at 4:30 a.m. on Saturday and will be reopened at 4:30 p.m. A map of the closures as well as alternate traffic routes will appear in next week's *Grizzly*.

Participants will begin arriving on Friday. From 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, activities, drawings and food concessions will be available in the Bartlett Road parking lot. KBHR will broadcast live on Saturday and a cruise around the lake will leave the dock at 4:30 p.m.
